CHAIR:

**PURPOSE:** To oversee and coordinate the Patient Blood Management Program.

CHARGES: 1. Coordinate, validate and review program assessment tool, assessor guidance and facility guidance

documents.

2. Outline a process/calendar for revising the PBM tool based upon the timeline for revision of the PBM Standards.

- 3. Maintain the PBM assessment tool and participate in the revision of assessor Handbook, assessor guidance and member guidance documents. Ensure consistency with the PBM Standards.
- 4. Plan and conduct assessor training at the Annual Meeting.
- 5. Evaluate and recruit adequate numbers of assessors with appropriate expertise to cover the accreditation categories as needed.
- 6. Serve as a resource for the Education Advisory Accreditation Committee to identify patient blood management services assessor training and institutional educational needs.
- 7. Review policies that relate to assessor qualifications and training. Provide suggestions for revisions.
- 8. As directed by APC, continually evaluate the function of the PBMAC.
